The City of Abbotsford's Planning & Development Services department is looking for a seasoned professional to join their dynamic team as a Building Official III. Reporting to the Manager, you will be responsible for the review, processing and issuance of building permit applications for complex buildings, and as needed conducting building reviews to ensure that the work complies with the approved drawings. The position is created to have the flexibility in deploying resources to plan checking or building inspections, or a combination depending on the volume of applications.

In this challenging role, you will utilize your specialized knowledge while focusing on more complex and problematic buildings to ensure compliance with approved plans, bylaws, acts, codes standards and regulations. You will utilize your analytical skills to provide interpretations and applicability of code requirements, product and alternative solution evaluations, construction methods and other City bylaws and communicates these decisions to customers, staff and the public.

Strong communication skills are essential as you work closely with a variety of internal and external stakeholders to answer inquiries and provide technical guidance. Your ability to coach and mentor junior staff will be invaluable as you help coordinate, assign work to and assist less experienced staff. Thorough knowledge of the B.C. Building Code B.C. - Membership with the Building Officials' Association of B.C. (BOABC) as a Registered Building Official or Canadian Registered Building Official.
